Located at the crest of the mountainous backbone of Africa, at the very center of the continent, the Virunga Mountains are the embodiment of western fantasies about "Darkest Africa." The Virungas are in the heart of the legendary land of King Solomon's mines, the long-sought source of the Nile, and the rumored lair of giant alligators, man-eating plants, and the cousins of King Kong. Blanketed by mists and bordered alternately by dense jungles filled with rampaging beasts and trackless deserts awash in blowing sand, the region around the Virungas was literally the last place in Africa visited by acquisitive Europeans. Although skirted by explorers in the 1850s, the Virungas were not actually seen by white men until the 1890s, only about a century ago. we organize gorilla tracking expeditions in Uganda Rwanda and Congo
